



Setup:

1. Prepare a set of Seva Cards with simple acts of service written on them.
Examples: "Smile at someone who is sad"; "Help a friend carry books"; "Clean the classroom corner"; "Say kind words to a teammate" etc
2. Prepare another set of Illusion Cards with tasks that seem to require money, fame, or position.
Examples: "Donate 100 rupees", "Give a speech to thousands"
3. Divide the class into 2 groups.

How to Play

1. Each team draws one card at a time.
 - If it's a Seva Card, they act it out immediately.
 - If it's an Illusion Card, the group must transform it into a way that can be done with love and creativity instead of money or fame.
Example: "Donate 100 rupees" → "Share something you have with a friend."
2. Teams earn points for:
 - Acting out Seva Cards joyfully (certain points)
 - Creatively transforming Illusion Cards into love-based actions (certain points)
3. After some rounds, the group who has more points will be the winner.

Value Badges:

Creative Transformer – turned Illusion into Seva,

Kind Heart – acted out Seva Cards with joy;

Seva Star – showed teamwork and sincerity;

Joyful Player – kept the spirit high
