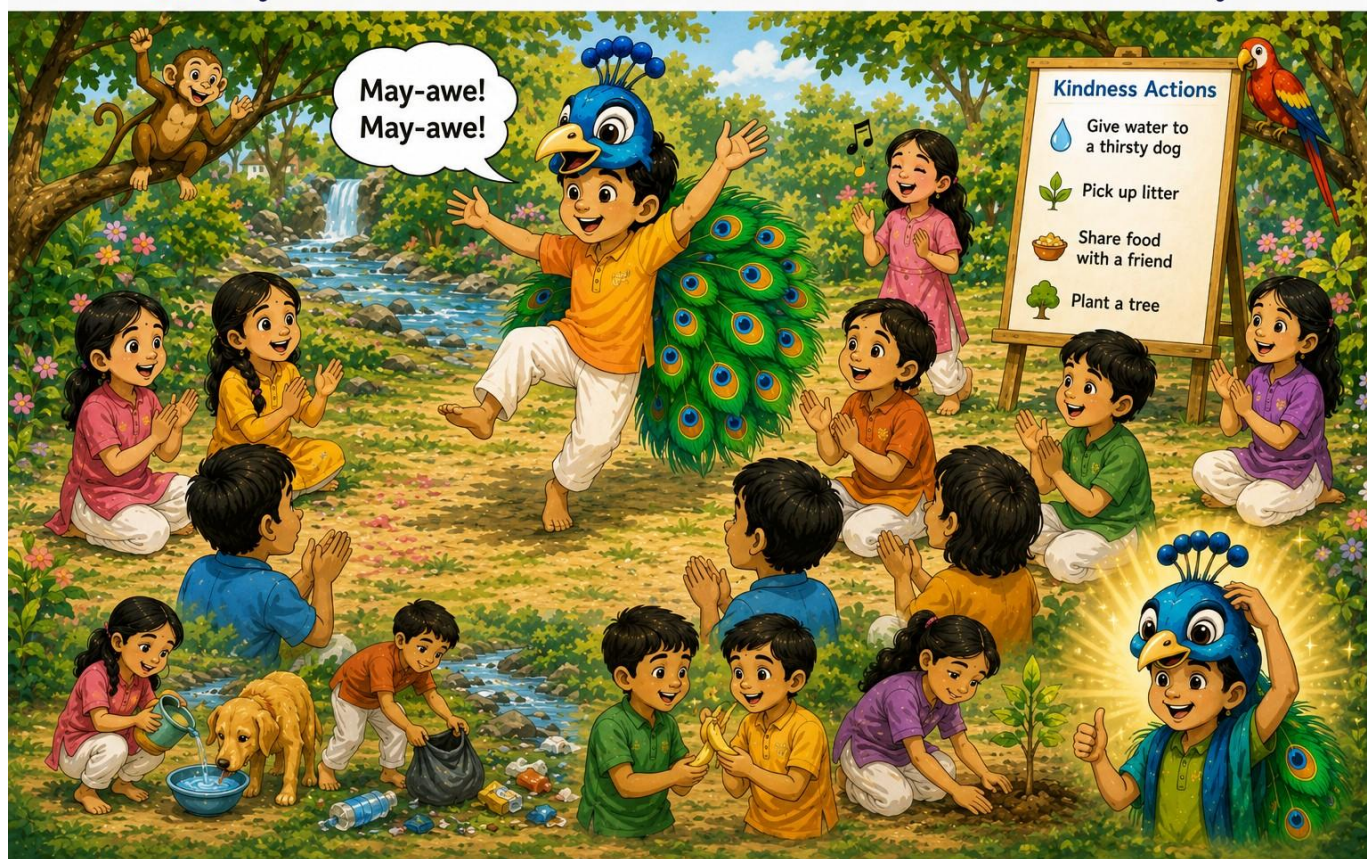


🇬🇧 Physical Class Game – Peacock's Dance of Kindness - SSSSB Story 076



Materials:

- A picture or mask of a peacock (optional)
- Small cards with "Kindness Actions" written on them (e.g., *Give water to a thirsty dog*, *Pick up litter*, *Share food with a friend*, *Plant a tree*)
- Music or one child sing a [devotional] song

How to Play

1. **Choose the Peacock:** One child plays the Peacock - holding the picture or mask of peacock.
2. **Jungle Dance:** The Peacock dances joyfully while the song is being sung. Other children clap like monkeys or sing like parrots.
3. **Peacock's Call:** When the music stops, the Peacock shouts: "*May-awe! May-awe!*"
4. **Kindness Action:** The Peacock picks one "Kindness Action" card and reads it aloud.
 - Example: "*Give water to a thirsty dog.*"
5. **Children Act It Out:** All children quickly act out the kindness action in a funny, exaggerated way – pretend to pour water, feed animal or clean the river.
6. **Peacock's Choice:** The Peacock chooses the funniest or most joyful performance. That child becomes the new Peacock.

Reflection: After 3–4 rounds, pause and ask:

- "*Which kindness action was your favorite?*"
- "*How can we do this in real life?*"
