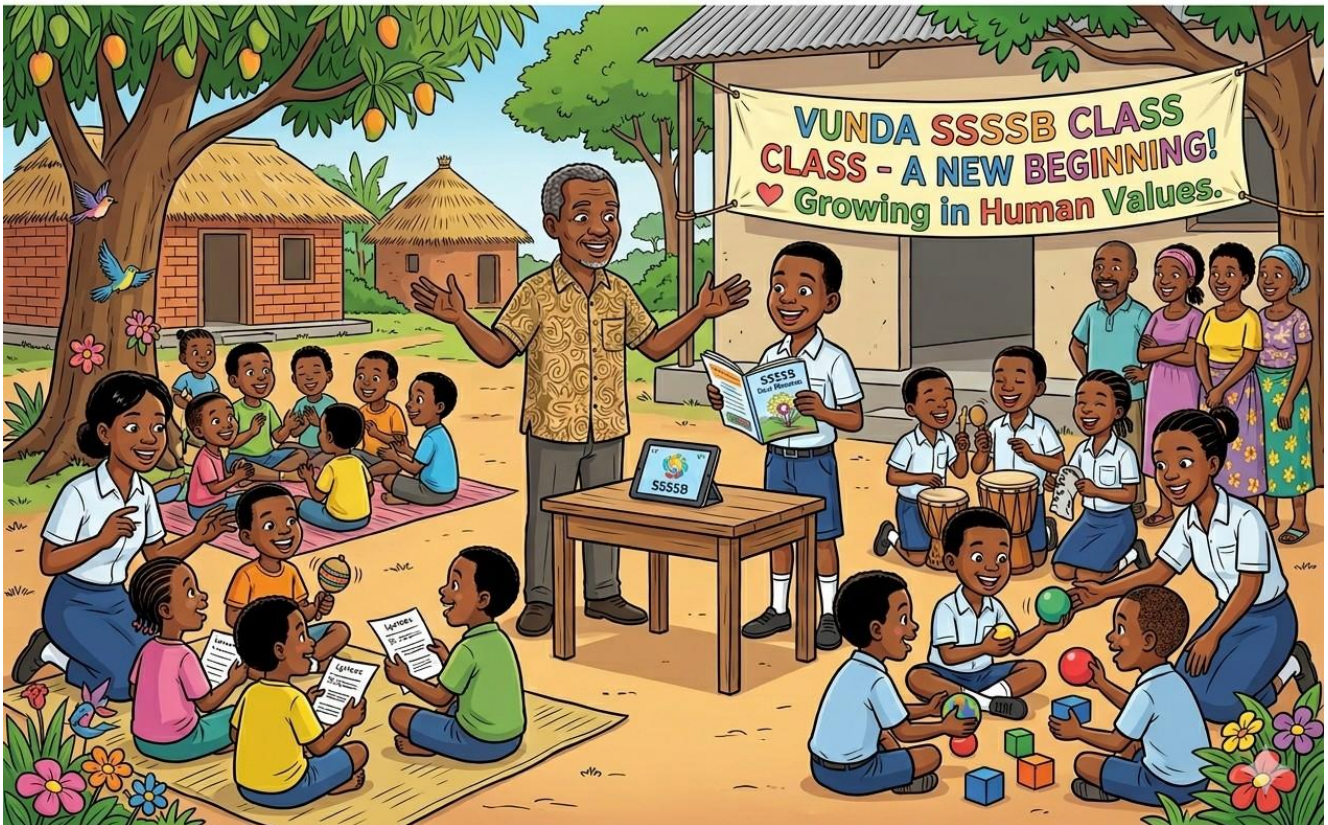


🇬🇧 SSSSB Story 024b: SSSSB Student Inspires the Entire School [13+ years]
