



Materials:

- “Wish Cards” (simple cards /papers with wishes written on them)
- Use something – eg a chair - as “The Wish Tree”
- Small blessing stars [children can draw stars on paper]

Examples of Wish Cards:

Good Wishes: I wish to become kinder. I wish to help my parents more. I wish to study well. I wish to care for nature.

Unwise Wishes: I want unlimited toys. I want to skip school forever! I want everything only for myself!

How to Play:

1. Place the Wish Tree in the middle
2. One child at a time takes 9 rounds around the tree while softly chanting: “**Om, Bhagwan Shri Sanjay Sai Babaye Nama**”
3. The child picks a Wish Card.
4. The class decides together: “Wise Wish or Unwise Wish?”
5. If it is a wise and value-based wish, the child gets a “Blessing Star” and says: “Good wishes help everyone!”
6. If it is an unwise wish, the child explains how to improve it.
Example:
 “I want everything for myself” →
 “I wish to share with others.”

Joyful Ending: All children stand around the tree and say together: “We choose wise wishes, good values, and love for all!”
