



**Setup:** Mark 4 big circles on the floor or playground labeled:

- i. Dreaming [eg. *One day I will help the poor. "When I grow up, I'll clean the city."* ]
- ii. Thinking – [eg. *Maybe I should help my parents now. I could share my lunch with a friend.*]
- iii. Doing – [eg. *Helping parents with chores today. Picking up litters. Sharing lunch.*]
- iv. Serving with Love - [eg. *Visiting sick or lonely neighbors with care. Always seeing the good in others and practicing values.*]

- Prepare small **Seva cards** with simple *actions* (e.g., Help parents, Clean the yard, Share lunch, Smile at everyone).
- Have a small bell or clap for joyful transitions.

**How to Play:**

- Children stand in a line at the *Dreaming* circle.
- The teacher reads out a situation: I will wait until I am rich.
- The first child picks a Seva card and says aloud: **"I can start now by..."** (then reads the action).
- The group cheers and or clap. The child moves one step forward to the next circle.
- Each round, more children join, showing how small actions lead to big change.
- When everyone reaches Serving with Love, the class sings together: **"We start now — we already have enough!"**
