



How to Play:

Children stand in a circle. The teacher reads an action. If it shows a **good value**, children shout: "Be Like Golu!" **clap and dance**.

If it does **not** show a good value, children say NO! NO!, fold their arms and stay silent.

Examples

- Helping a friend who fell down. **Be Like Golu!**
- Sharing your pencils. **Be Like Golu!**
- Waiting patiently for your turn. **Be Like Golu!**
- Speaking kindly to others. **Be Like Golu!**
- Showing off and saying, "I am the best!" Say NO! NO! fold their arms and stay silent.
- Laughing when someone makes a mistake. Say NO! NO! fold their arms and stay silent.
- Refusing to help others. Say NO! NO! fold their arms and stay silent.

Fun Ending

Ask: "**Who wants to win Golu's Friendship Prize?**"

All children raise their hands and together say: "**I will be kind, helpful, calm, and disciplined!**"
