



How to Play

1. **Choose a Lion:** One child plays the Lion King (pretending to be sick and weak).
2. **Forest Friends:** Other children play Deer, Owl, Squirrel, Elephant, Horse, and more.
3. **Secret Helpers:** Each forest friend secretly decides one way to help the Lion **without saying "we are helping you."** Examples:
 - Bring a pretend fruit or nut.
 - Sing a blissful devotional song.
 - Crown the Lion with a paper wreath labeled "Protector of the Forest."
4. **Celebration Round:** All children gather around the Lion and act out a joyful ceremony or honoring the Lion. Along the title "Protector of the Forest", the Lion receives nutritious food, blissful devotional songs, and the wreath. It acts as if he regains health, and strong again.
5. **Lion's Realization:** At the end, the Lion roars aloud:
"Power and strength may fade, but kindness and respect make me strong."
