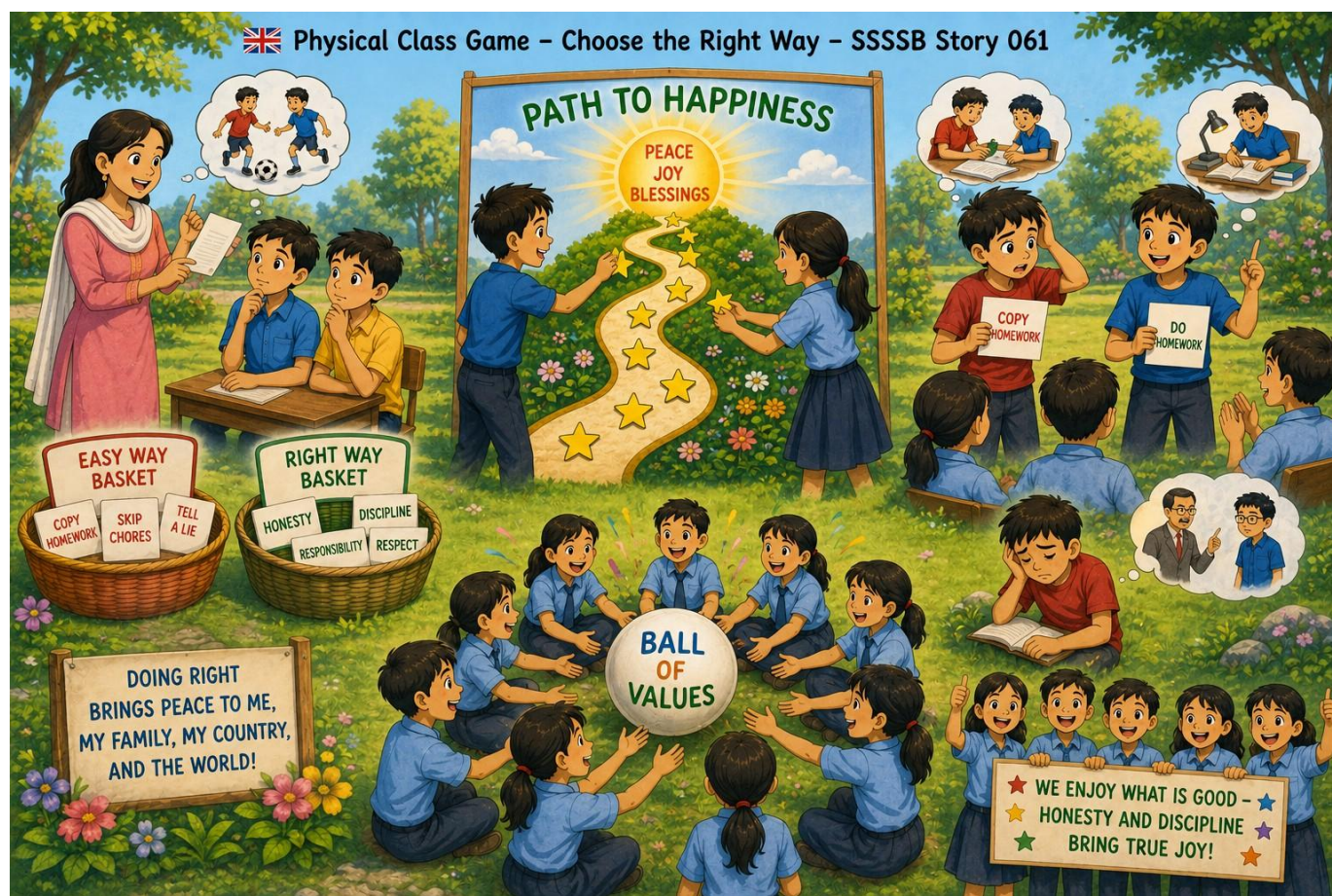




Setup

- Prepare two baskets:
 - **Easy Way Basket** (cards with shortcuts like *Copy homework*, *Skip chores*, *Tell a lie*).
 - **Right Way Basket** (cards with values like *Honesty*, *Discipline*, *Responsibility*, *Respect*).
- Make a big poster - or draw on the floor - **Path to Happiness** (a road leading to a shining sun with the words *Peace*, *Joy*, *Blessings*).

How to Play

1. **Role Play Choices:** Teacher reads short situations (e.g., “Homework is due tomorrow, but friends want to play today”). One child picks a card from the **Easy Way Basket**, other picks from the **Right Way Basket**. They act out what happens next.
2. **Class Reflection:** The class claps for the “**Right Way**” choice and discusses how it brings peace, appreciation, and blessings. The “**Easy Way**” choice is discussed too — showing how it may seem fun but causes problems later.
3. **Path to Happiness:** Each time a child chooses the Right Way, they place a bright sticker [or draw a star] on the Path to Happiness poster. When the path is full of stars, the class chants together: “We enjoy what is good — honesty and discipline bring true joy!”

Joyful Ending: Children form a circle and pass a “Ball of Values” while saying: “Doing right brings peace to me, my family, my country, and the world!”
