

🇬🇧 Physical Class Game – The Missing Dollar – Patience & Perseverance - SSSSB Story 035



Setup:

- Take a box, name it the Sports and Games Box, put some toys or other item in it. Children can write on a piece of paper like football, tangram, tennis etc. and put in the box
- Place 5 paper coins (each worth \$1) beside it.
- Tell the children: “ArawMoto has saved 4 dollars. He needs 1 more to buy the box. Let’s help him earn it!”

How to Play:

1. Divide the class into 2 groups.
2. Each group takes turns answering a simple value question or performing a kind action. Examples:
 - “Say one kind word about your friend.”
 - “What does patience mean?”
 - “Show how you would share a toy.” etc
3. For every correct answer or kind action, the group earns one coin for ArawMoto.
4. When the class collects the missing coin, they shout together: “Hooray! ArawMoto can buy the Sports and Games Box!”

Reflection: After the game, ask:

- “How did ArawMoto show patience?”
- “Why is saving important?”
- “How can we practice perseverance in our own lives?”
