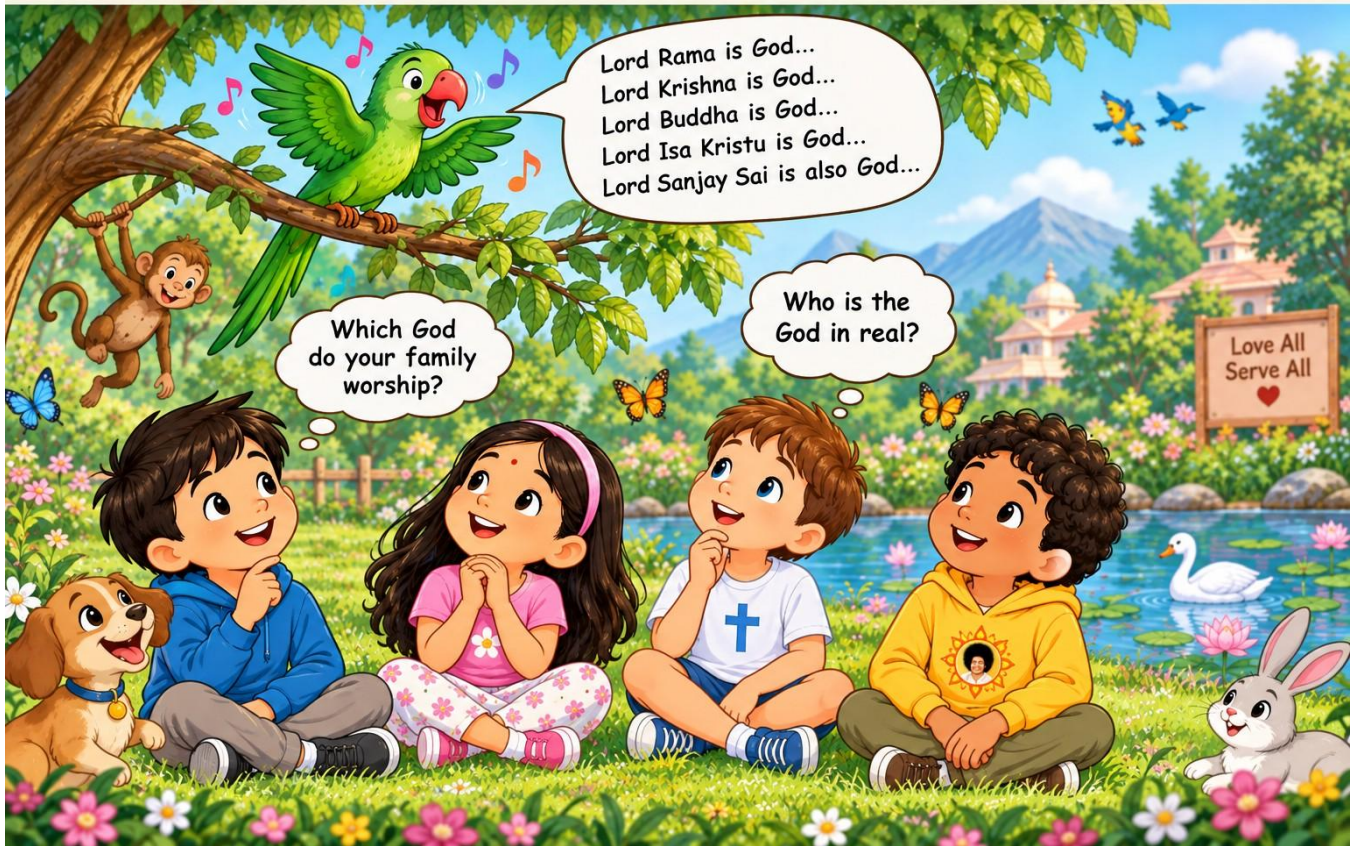


🇬🇧 SSSSB Story 079a: The Garden of Many Names of a God [5-12 years]
