

🇬🇧 Physical Class Game – Kindness Treasure Hunt – SSSSB Story 051



How to Play

1. Setup:

- Place cards or slips of paper around the classroom/playground.
- Each card has a short situation written on it (e.g., “A friend forgot their pencil”, “Someone is sad on their birthday”, “A classmate struggles with homework”).
- Each card also has a hidden “Kindness Treasure” symbol (like a star, heart, or smiley).

2. Story Connection:

- The teacher says: “We will go on a treasure hunt to find kindness everywhere!”

3. Children’s Action:

- Children search for the cards.
- When they find one, they read the situation aloud.
- They must say or act out a kind response (e.g., “I would lend my pencil”, “I would make a birthday card”).

4. Winning:

- Every child who finds a card and shares a kind action earns a “Kindness Treasure” (a sticker, clap, or cheer).
- The whole class wins when all treasures are found, showing that kindness is everywhere.
