

🇬🇧 Physical Class Game – Tweet-Tweet Story Builders - SSSSB Story 047



Game Setup

- **Players:** Children in 2 groups, one child plays parakeet, holding a toy parakeet or drawing on face.
- **Materials:**
 - Paper or small notebooks, Crayons or pencil
 - A toy bird or paper parakeet (symbol of creativity)
 - Timer or bell

How to Play

1. **Meet the Parakeet!** The parakeet child– holding a drawing or toy parakeet on his face. “Tweet-tweet! I’m the Creative Parakeet. I’ll help you make a story!”
2. **Form Story Teams** Divide children into 2 groups. Each group gets one sheet of paper and pencil or crayons.
3. **Start the Story** The parakeet gives the beginning: “*Once upon a time, there was a Grandma and Grandpa who couldn’t go to school...*”
4. **Add Ideas in Turns** Each child adds one sentence or drawing to continue the story. Example:
 - Child 1: “The grandchildren wanted to help them learn.”
 - Child 2: “They made big alphabet cards!”
 - Child 3: “The parakeet helped by singing the ABC song!”
5. **Tweet-Tweet Time!** When the bell rings, the parakeet “flies” to another group and gives a new idea or challenge: “*Add something funny!*” or “*Add something kind!*”
6. **Finish with a Message** Each group ends their story with a moral — something about kindness, courage, or learning.
7. **Share and Celebrate** Groups read their stories aloud. The parakeet cheers: “*Tweet-tweet! You are all brave storytellers!*”
