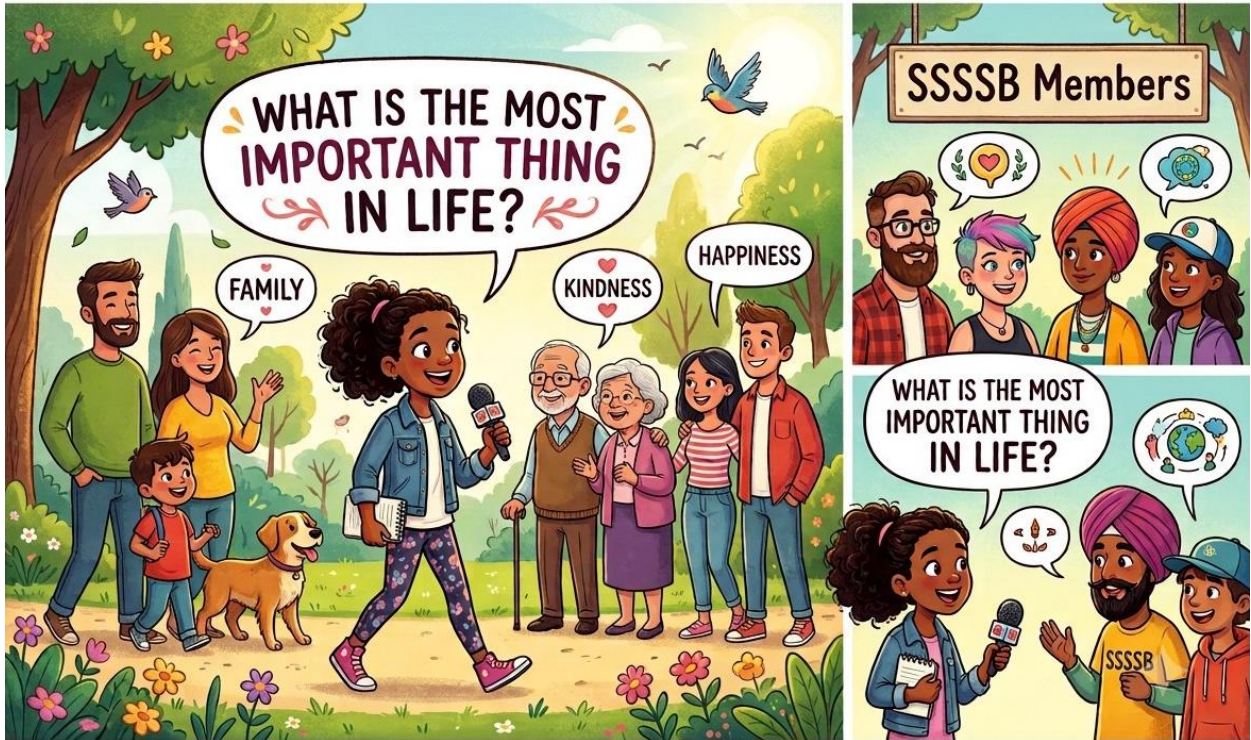


🇬🇧 SSSSB Story 041b: The Question Girl [13+years]
