



How to Play:

1. Children stand in a circle.
2. The leader calls out one of these:
 - **Village!**
 - **City!**
 - **Nature!**
3. Children must quickly do the matching action, for example:
 - Village – Pretend to plant seeds and say, "Grow, Grow!"
 - City – Pretend to read a book and say, "Learn, Learn!"
 - Nature – Stretch like a tree and say, "Protect, Protect!"

After a few rounds, the leader calls: "Balanced Development!"

Everyone joins hands and says: "Learn, grow, and protect nature and resources together!"

Fun Twist: If the leader calls:

- **Monkey!** → Scratch your head.
- **Parrot!** → Say, "Share! Share! Share!"
- **Squirrel!** → Pretend to hide a nut.

Anyone who does the wrong action gives **one idea to help nature** (save water, plant a tree, feed birds, etc.).
