



### Setup

- Each child receives a small card or slip of paper.
- On the card, they write one value they practice daily (e.g., helping mother at home, assisting a sibling with homework, helping elders on the way).
- Cards are placed in a basket.

### How to Play

#### 1. Circle Sharing

- Children sit in a circle.
- One child picks a card from the basket (not their own).
- They read the value aloud and say: *“This inspires me because...”* and add one sentence about how they could practice or encourage that value.

#### 2. Story Building

- After 3–4 children share, the group works together to build a short “value story” combining those examples.
- Example: Helping at home + helping a sibling + helping elders → becomes a story about *“Helping everywhere brings joy.”*

#### 3. Joyful Action

- The group acts out the story in a short role-play (2–3 minutes).
- Everyone claps and celebrates the values shown.

**Ending Chant:** The teacher leads the children in a joyful chant: *“Values are seeds, calmness is the soil, stories are flowers of goodness!”*
