

## 🇬🇧 Physical Class Game – Bunny’s Value Hunt - SSSSB Story 066



**Setup:** Classroom or playground. Props: Small cards or slips of paper with values written on them (Kindness, Discipline, Respect, Helping, Calmness). A basket or box (the “Value Basket”)

### How to Play

1. **Scatter Values:** Hide the value cards around the play area (under chairs, behind books, near trees).
2. **Roles:** One child is the **Bunny Leader**. The rest are **Value Hunters**.
3. **Game Flow:**
  - The Bunny Leader guides the group, reminding them: “Stay polite, stay calm, and help each other.”
  - Value Hunters search for the hidden cards.
  - When a child finds a card, they must **say the value aloud** (e.g., “Kindness!”) and place it in the Value Basket.
4. **Helping Rule:**
  - If someone struggles to find a card, others can give gentle hints.
  - Helping earns bonus claps or cheers from the group.
5. **Winning Together:**
  - The game ends when all values are collected.
  - Everyone wins together because the basket is full of values!

At the end, children sit in a circle and each picks one card from the basket to share how they can practice that value at home or school.
